

## Week 18 report

The final of the Habershon cup will be played between Piranha B and holders LSM B, Piranha overcame the youngsters of Scorpions C by just 12 points, the tie looked to be going Piranhas way but when Richard Element held Steve Taylor to 7 points it left Terry Curran needing to beat Will Boardman convincingly and the wily old campaigner had too much for the up and coming youngster. The other semi final was heading for a close finish until the seventh set when Steve Wilson beat Jimmy Jeickles 41-29 and the tie was effectively over with LSM winning 372-316.

In the first division LSM A's title chances ended with two home defeats, firstly losing 7-3 to Piranha A for whom Chris Cattell, Andrea Baldi and Steve Lyons all scored twice, as did Pete Morgan jnr for LSM. They then lost to league leaders JSM 8-2 with Ben Barlow unbeaten but Pete Morgan jnr did have the satisfaction of beating his old man and Abhi Darshane. Piranha A remain contenders with a 9-1 win against an under strength Piranha B, hat tricks for Andrea Baldi and Lance Webster ensured victory. Scorpions A are also in with a shout and they also had a 9-1 win against Phoenix C. Piranha E almost ensured their survival with a 10-0 walkover against their D team. Hat tricks from Steve Taylor and Alan Henson gave Piranha C a 6-4 victory at Phoenix B. Another 9-1 scoreline saw Phoenix A win at Scorpions B with maximums for Mick Jarvis and Mick Bell but Robert Swift halting the whitewash with a win over Stuart Element.

LSM B confirmed promotion with a 9-1 win at 2 man Phoenix E John Bradshaw and Jeff Calvert were unbeaten but Steve Wilson lost to Eric Twigg. LSM C kept up their promotion push with a 6-4 win at home to Phoenix D, Steve Forster took the honours remaining unbeaten all night including the doubles with Trevor Bland who scored twice losing to John Hallgarth. Dolcliffe had to overcome a Mick Brownlow hat trick but came out 7-3 winners at home to Stag B to keep up the pressure on LSM C. Piranha F almost certainly ensured survival with a 6-4 win against Scorpions D, another Anthony Parkin maximum, 2 for Craig Burns and the pair combined for the doubles, for Scorpions Phil Richardson scored twice.

Scorpions E all but secured the third division title after Piranha I conceded, Clifton Cobras will be second after beating Scorpions F 7-3, a Russ Drayton maximum led the way and Jim Steel weighed in with 2, for Scorpions Matthew Stotton scored twice. The closest match of the week was between Piranha H and Clifton Cobras, 2 man Clifton had Francis Lovell unbeaten all night and led 5-4 but Matt Hicks kept his nerve to beat Lee McClelland 15-13 in the 5th game to force a draw.
